At the heart of our operations is our state-of-the-art Victorian plant, where we carefully collect, sort by type, and treat water-based paints through innovative, eco-friendly processes.









The reduction in virgin material use and local supply reduces embodied carbon by approximately 15kg of CO2 emissions per 100L.

### **Usage** Instructions



### **Preparation**

Surface must be clean, dry and free from dust, oils and grease prior to application.



### **Apply**

Applies well with a brush or a roller.



### **How to Apply**

- **1.** Stir paint thoroughly with a flat paddle using an up-and-down scooping action.
- **2.** Cut-in around the edges with a brush, then roll up to the border whilst it is still wet.
- **3.** Apply additional coats as required, ensuring that the previous coat is completely dry before applying.

### Case Study Graffiti Concealment

The City of Melbourne has long grappled with graffiti vandalism. Traditional removal methods were time-consuming and used virgin products.

In November 2024, Paintback partnered with the City of Melbourne to trial the use of Paintback's reclaimed water-based paint to combat graffiti. Northbank Central, situated in the heart of Melbourne's CBD, served as the site for the trial, focusing on its apartment building and car park.

Rafael G, the building manager partnering in the project, was impressed by Paintback Greyscale Paints' performance. Applied with standard rollers, Greyscale Paint requires just one coat per panel for complete coverage.

"Only one coat applied of recycled paint which covered the graffiti with no bleed through. Amazing paint product that is good for the environment given it comes from recycled paint."
